On The Process

- Reading/response time is lengthy. Be patient.
- Your bio/cover letter should be brief. It's preferred there is no details about your story in the letter other than the title and word count. Editors would like the piece to speak for itself.
- Follow the guidelines for any style requirements mentioned by the editors.

What Next?

1. Identify whether your piece is fiction / flash fiction (1,000 words or less) / nonfiction / etc. and keep your eye on publications that fit your piece.
2. Check reading periods and eliminate publications that are irrelevant at the time of submission.
3. Check for word count length and find the publications that fit your word count.
4. Check publication tags to make sure you DO NOT submit to a publication outside your genre (general fiction / science fiction / fantasy / speculative fiction / romance / horror / comedy / children's / etc.)
5. Read the submission guidelines for the publications that fit your criteria above.
6. Craft a short bio (cover letter) to go along with your submission.
7. Submit! Submit! Submit and work on simultaneous submissions with the publications that allow for it.
